



Number of Lawsuits Filed








No. of 60-Day Notices 2015 - 2017










Number 60-Day Notices Sent Jan '15 - Dec '17




Simple, scalable strategy

- 1. Pick a location
- 2. Team up with a **private citizen**
- 3. Identify facilities not in compliance
- 4. Download rain data from NOAA to document 'unpermitted discharge' violations
- 5. Detail alleged violations in 60-Day Notice
- 6. Send 60-Day Notice
- 7. Wait 60 days to determine if the facility will settle



Top 7 Environmental Groups (CA)




Number 60-Day Notices Sent Jan '15 - Dec '17

Time - 3 years

Settlements - \$80K per facility







- Regional Water Quality Control Board
- Notice to Comply
- Notice of Violation
- Administrative Civil Liability
- Cleanup and Abatement Order
- Citizen's Suits commenced with Notice of Intent to Sue

Enforcement Prevention & Response Citizen Suits Proactive Compliance Strategies

- Be Proactive
- Review your public access SMARTS file
 - Previous NOVs from Water Board, is the SWPPP and the site map up to date
- Sample last year
 - Due to structural BMPs, lack of rain, other circumstances
- Rain Event Log on site
 - Rain gauge? Tracking log
- ERA Level 1 or Level 2?
 - Implemented additional BMPs
 - Updated SWPPP based on Level 1 or Level 2 Report

Enforcement Prevention & Response Citizen Suits Proactive Compliance Strategies

SWPPP

- Consistent implementation throughout SWPPP?
- Does the site map match the SWPPP?

Site Map

 Without looking at the SWPPP, does the site map provide the reader enough information? (e.g., structural overhead coverage is marked, treatment system is clearly identified, note on map if facility rarely discharges due to infiltration)

Castellon & Funderburk LLP's Defensive Playbook

Enforcement Prevention & Response Citizen Suits Defensive Strategies

- Challenge sufficiency/adequacy of notice of intent to sue (citizen suit)
- Audit, evaluate and achieve compliance in the 60-day notice period (have topo map, if possible, to prove drainage routes)
- Retain expert who will testify that BAT/BCT is met at the end of the 60-day notice period
- Gwaltney v. Chesapeake Bay Found., 484 U.S. 49 (1987)
- Pre-empt lawsuit by having Regional Water Board or EPA oust jurisdiction from citizen group (very difficult and has several risks; may be better to obtain opinion on compliance)

Enforcement Prevention & Response Citizen Suits Consent Decrees

- Attorney's fees (your own: \$25k \$250k pre trial)
- Attorney's fees (theirs: \$40k-\$400k the sky's the limit)
- Remediation component (implementation of BMPs over strict 2-5 year schedule: \$100k - \$1 million' also includes \$\$ for compliance monitoring)
- Supplemental Environmental Project (also called a SEP involves donation to environmental mitigation project/group approved by Justice Dept.: \$25k to \$500k)
- California groups include Keeper organizations, Sportfishing and Surfriders, individuals
